

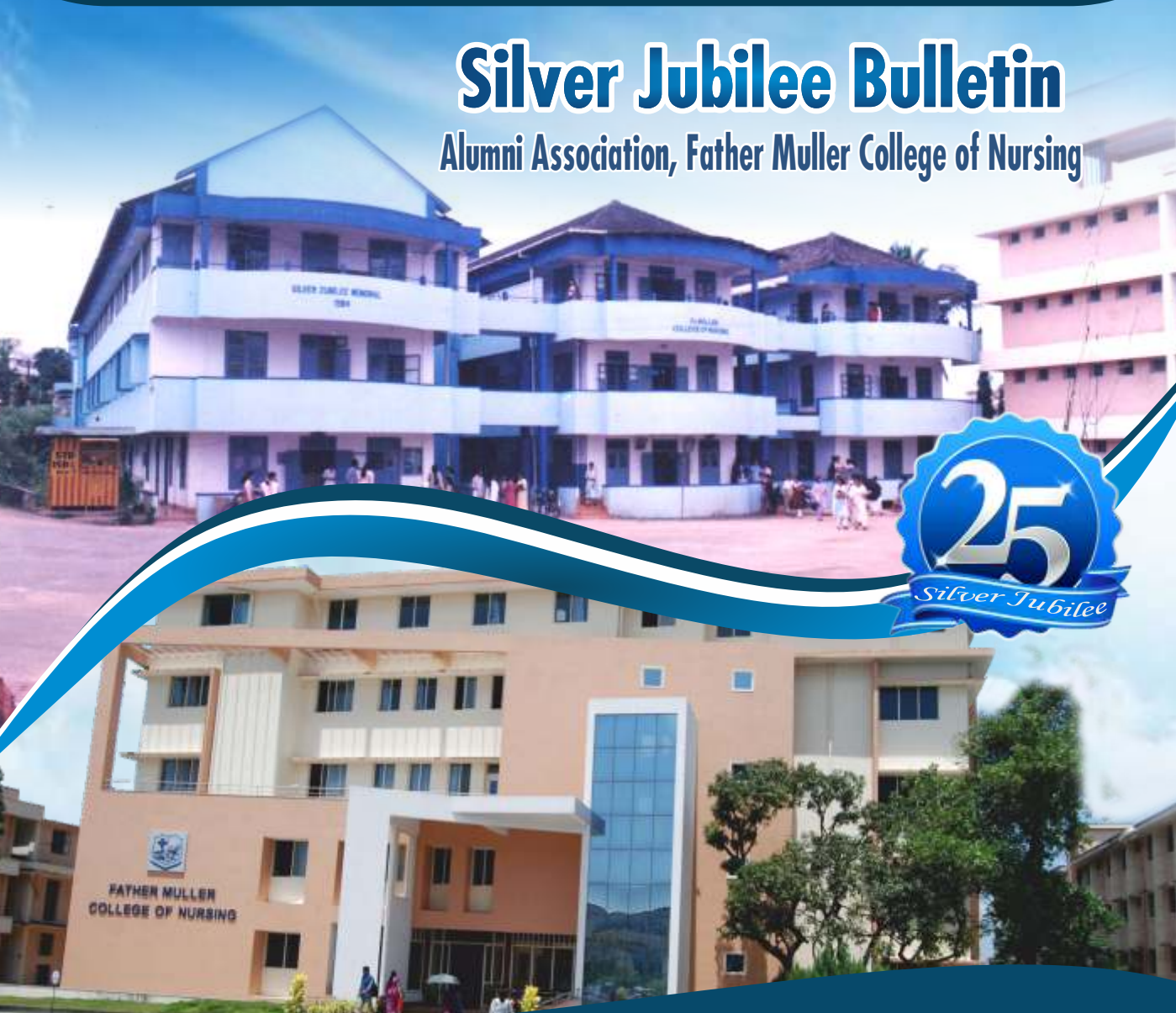

Father Muller College of Nursing was established in the year 1987. It is the first college to begin with a B.Sc nursing program in Mangalore and the first private nursing college in Karnataka. In the humble beginning, the 26 students had their academic exposure in a small building with few resources. The scarcity of resources did not fall in a shortage in learning. The dedicated teachers, under the guidance of Madam Thiagarajan, the Founder principal, and a bunch of devoted teachers, helped the students become fully pledged, professional nurses. The Catholic Diocese of Mangalore always strives hard to meet the needs of society. Over the years, accelerated infrastructure and facilities at the campus. Today, the college has ICT enabled campus, vast clinical exposure, huge loads of databases and e-resources at the library, high-fidelity mannequins at the simulation center, and excellent, efficient faculty that attract students to pursue their studies at Father Muller College of Nursing. Today, it is well-known all over the globe for graduating professional nurses with the knowledge, skill, and passion for serving humanity. In 1997, Madam Annamma T U, the principal of that period, and the Vice principal Rev. Sr Loredana Korah, understood the essence of graduates and initiated the Alumni association. As a result, the association has completed a glorious 25 years this year. Alumni ambassadors rightly hail the institution and connect it with various communities, corporates, and entrepreneurs. Rev Sr. Jacintha D'Souza led this association as a charter president. Dear Friends,

Happy reminiscences surge out of my soul as I look back at the tremendous growth and development which the College has already secured reaching to the zenith of its excellence, thanks to the hard work of the principals and the team of veteran staff members under the guidance of the NABH team. At this juncture what message shall I impart? Remember friends that the world is mounting high up towards unimaginable medical discoveries such as, replacing any bone of the skeletal system as well as the soft tissues of any organ with scientifically computerized ones with the present advancement and progress in technology, in the field of knowledge and practice and the keywords today is globalization.

You need to get geared to face the global modern nursing world focused on curriculum innovations in Nursing Education as the scientific knowledge and technology expanded enormously, and healthcare practice arena is changing fast still rapidly.

New challenges in practice include an aging population, a shift from acute to chronic diseases in patients and therefore in treatment models, increasing attention to patient safety and quality of care, and recurrent calls to decrease healthcare costs. Student demographics have also shifted, and new technology offers alternative delivery systems. Both classroom and clinical teaching systems pose challenges in the current environment of the advanced countries. A new system for the integration of these two domains is needed, along with greater support for the transition from education to practice.

What I personally want to insist is on preserving the original Charism or the Spirit of Nursing- "Caring" as the core point in nursing. We inculcate the 'Motto of Service' in students. We prepare students who are well trained to face the challenges in their professional career. Remember friends, excellence is not inborn but developed as the challenges increase.

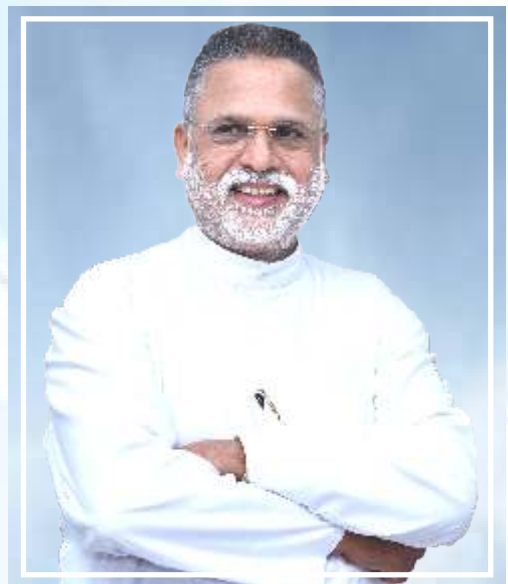

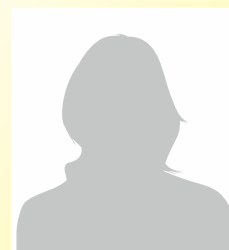
